The College of Education and Allied Studies is looking forward to honoring you at the Commencement Ceremonies. Please note the following departments/programs of students receiving Doctorate, Master's and Bachelor's degrees and/or credential certificates from CEAS:

All students are to **arrive** at the soccer practice field (next to the Baseball Diamond) and parking lot N **at the latest, by 4:00 p.m.**, for registration, line-up and information. The ceremony will begin promptly at 5:00 p.m. You will be asked to complete an announcer card when you register. Make sure you indicate your degree, department or program, and/or your credential you are receiving. **Keep this card with you.** You will be handing it to the reader on stage. It will also be used to keep the photographs in order.

Each student will walk across the stage once. Therefore, if you are getting both a degree and a credential, you must decide before commencement which group of students you would like to walk with: Those students receiving a degree, or those receiving a credential certificate.

Please follow the directions of the Faculty Marshals who will lead you and guide you throughout the ceremony.

Because the ceremony will be ending around dinner time, there will be no reception.

## *General Commencement Information for All Colleges*



**Commencement ceremonies** for all colleges will take place **in the University Stadium.**

**Parking** for all students and guests **is open** to any open lot: no special parking passes will be required.

There is **no restriction on the number of guests** a student may invite.

**Students** are requested **to arrive at the soccer practice field** next to Parking Lot N, **1.5 hours (at minimum, 1 hour) before the start of the ceremony** to register, line-up, and receive instructions.

**Students' Footwear Consideration:** You will be walking on stairs, ramps, grass, asphalt, and dirt.

**Bottled water** will be **available for students** to take to their seats.

Suggest to your **guests to be prepared for the weather** with sunscreen, umbrellas, and/or hats.

**Photographs will be taken** on stage, one with **only the student and** one **while shaking the President's hand.**

**Students** are requested to **return to their original seats after walking across the stage** and remaining in their seats until the end of the ceremony.

### **Logistics for Students with Disabilities:**

- **Parking will be in Lots L and M.** The car must have an appropriate license plate for the disabled to be allowed entry into Lots L and M.
- **Campus shuttle buses** will stop frequently at designated signs at all open parking lots to pick-up students and guests who are disabled and need assistance to the stadium field.
- **Only one assistant per disabled student/guest** will be allowed on the shuttle, field and in the specially designated area for the disabled.
- **Students are requested to inform the Student Disability & Resource Center** (SDRC: 885-3868) if special accommodations are necessary for walking across the grass, onto the ramp up to the stage, and across the stage.
- There will be a **sign language interpreter** for the ceremony.
